- APH classification
- Late April, early May planting
- Excellent crown rot resistance



- APH classification
- Mid-late April planting
- Short plant, high yield



- APH quality Clearfield variety
- Superior yield to Suntop
- Suntop maturity



- AH classification, mid-slow maturing
- Exceptionally high yield
- Plant height similar to Lancer

BARLEY VARIETIES



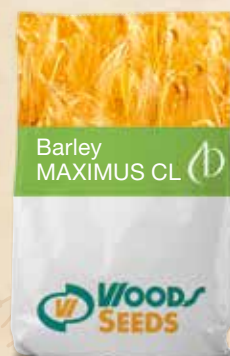
- Feed barley (undergoing malt evaluation)
- Medium-tall plant height
- Improved yield over Compass



- Feed quality
- Very high yield in low-medium rainfall
- Quicker maturity than Compass



- Feed barley (undergoing malt evaluation)
- Very good standability
- Option for early season planting



- High yielding Clearfield
- Improved disease compared to Spartacus
- Erect plant type, strong lodging tolerance



- Improved yield over Kyabra & Seamer
- Disease ratings similar to HatTrick
- Erect plant type with good harvestability
